



The Fall-The Flood

Lesson Five

Lesson Overview

Scripture – Genesis 6:11-22; 7:6-10, 17-23; 8:1-4, 15-17, 20-22; 9:12-17

Main Point – The world grew and God saw that all humans were sinful, except one family who loved God. God decided to flood the world, but made a covenant with one family to carry on God's plan in the world.

Craft – Rainbow covenant craft

Song – The Arky, Arky song

Note to the Teacher

Before presenting this lesson, we encourage you to read the scripture passages and understand the story for yourself. This lesson plan is meant to give you direction as you teach, but it is important to share the story from your heart and allow God to lead you as you go.

Lesson Outline

Read the Scripture

Genesis 6–9

Help the children retell the story in their own words.

- What happened first?
- What happened next?
- What happened last?

For younger students...

Discuss the story with the students.

- What did Noah build?
- Who got on the ark?
- What did God put in the sky to remind Noah and his family of the covenant?

For older students...

Discuss the story with the students.

- What does this story say about God?
- What does this story say about us?
- What do we need to obey from this passage?

Do the craft with the students.

Craft Instructions

In this lesson we learned about the flood and God's covenant with Noah! You can use this craft with the students to help them remember the lesson that they learned today!

Materials

- Pre-made coloring sheet
- Crepe Paper (red, orange, yellow, green and blue)
- Glue

Instructions

Note: Before doing this craft with the students, cut the crepe paper into small squares.

Step 1 - Hand out the pre-made coloring sheet.

Step 2 - Explain to the students how to glue the crepe paper onto the pre-made coloring sheet in the shape of a rainbow.

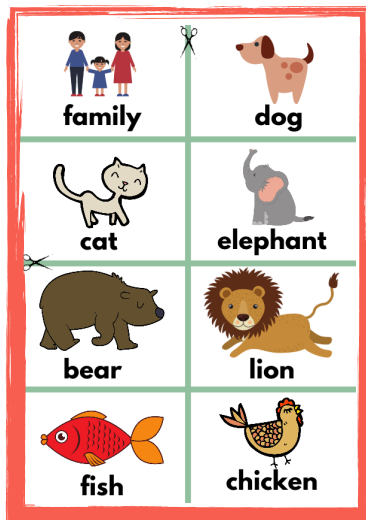
Step 3 - Allow the children to glue the crepe paper onto their own coloring sheet. Talk about how the rainbow is a reminder of the covenant that God made with Noah.

Step 4 - Allow the children to bring their coloring sheet home or hang it on your classroom walls.

Flash Cards

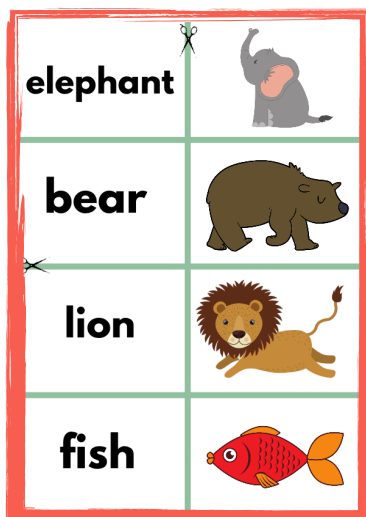


Step 1- Cut out each card along the green lines.

Step 2- Use the flash cards to teach the students the English word for each picture.

Step 3- Optional: Punch a hole in the top left corner of each card. Put them on a ring and have the students practice flipping through the cards while reading each word.

Matching Game



Step 1- Cut out each card along the green lines.

Step 2- Teach the children the English words by connecting them with the corresponding picture. If you need help matching them, look at the flash cards.

Step 3- Matching Game: Spread out the cards face-up on a flat surface. Make sure that they are mixed up. Have the children pick up a word or picture card and match it with the corresponding word or picture.
